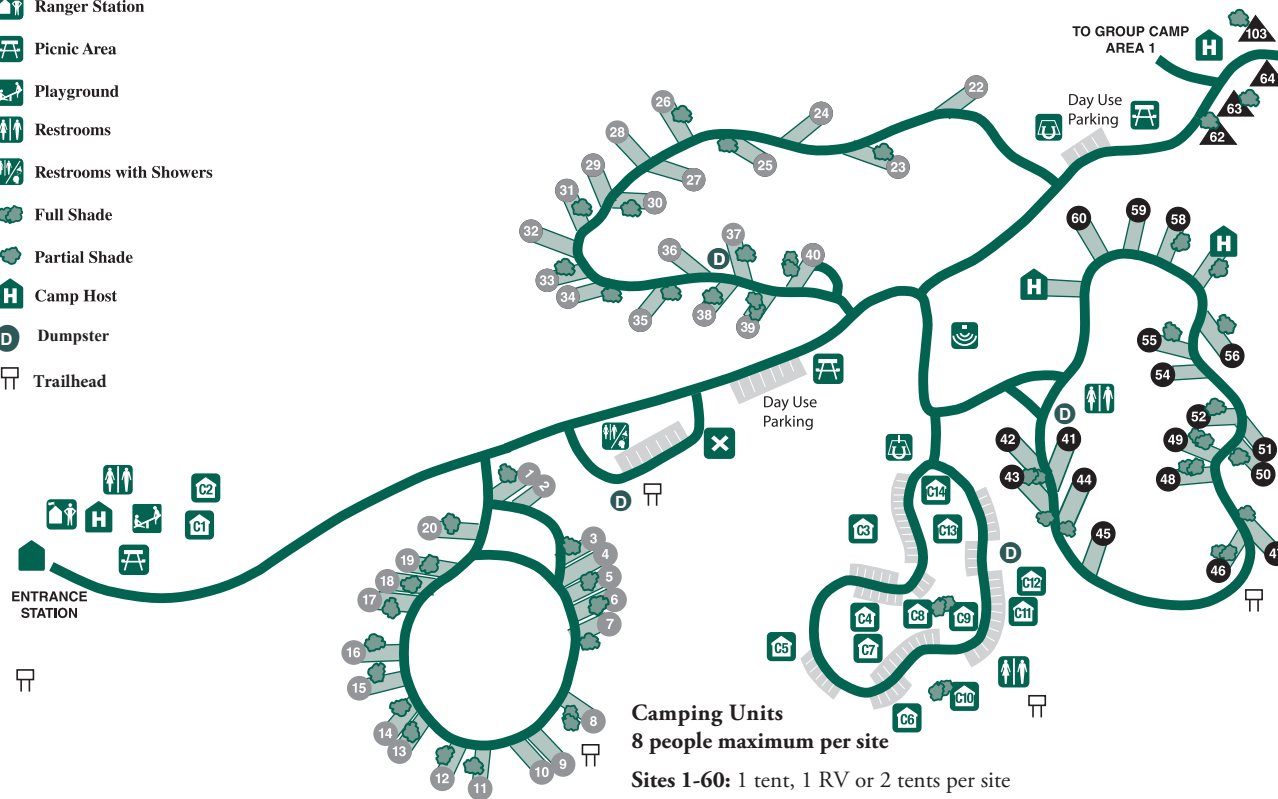
This is a vacation family camping park. Occupancy in the park is contingent upon guests maintaining their immediate camping area in a safe and clean condition and complying with all park rules. Failure to comply will result in a suspension of camping privileges and a loss of prepaid fees.

Campfires: Fire and flame must be confined to existing stoves or fire-rings. Tiki torches are not allowed. During a fire ban, campfires are not allowed and only fuel-stoves may be used. Please check with the ranger for current fire conditions. Fires must be totally out between 11 p.m. and 7 a.m. with water.

Quiet Hours: 10 p.m. – 8 a.m. No music or loud voices

Additional park regulations are on reverse side.

Violators will lose all privileges and face eviction: No exceptions!

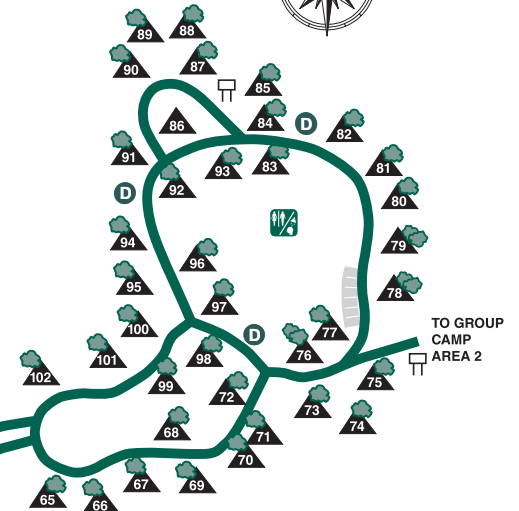


Camping Units

Cabins: 6 people maximum per cabin

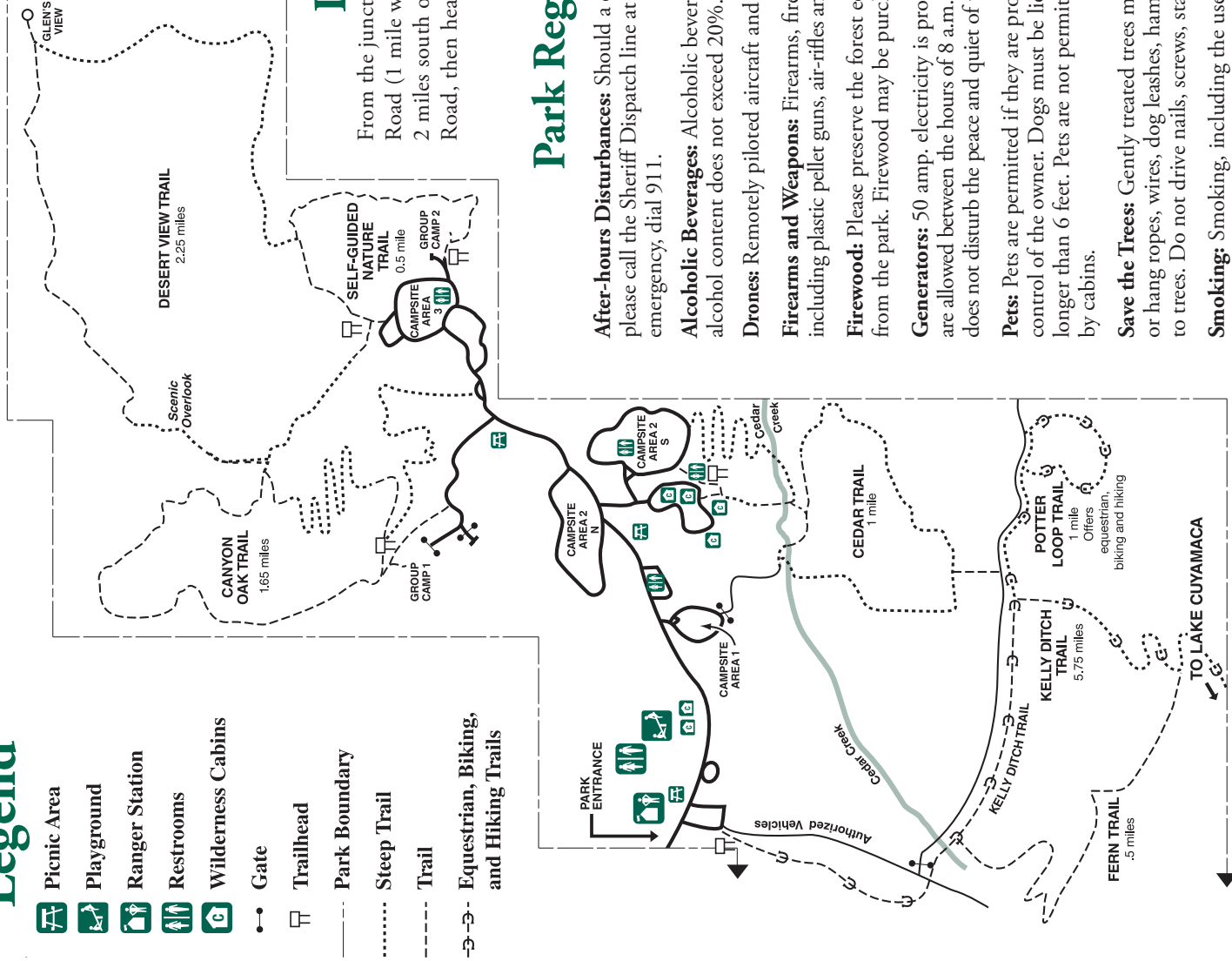

Directions

From the junction of Highway 79 and Pine Hills Road (1 mile west of the town of Julian), head 2 miles south on Pine Hills Road to Frisius Road, then head east for 2 miles.

Park Regulations

After-hours Disturbances: Should a disturbance occur after hours, please call the Sheriff Dispatch line at 858-565-5200. In case of an emergency, dial 911.

Alcoholic Beverages: Alcoholic beverages are permitted providing the alcohol content does not exceed 20%. (beer/wine are ok, liquor is not).

Drones: Remotely piloted aircraft and drones are prohibited.

Firearms and Weapons: Firearms, fireworks, and weapons of all types including plastic pellet guns, air-rifles and paint-ball guns are not permitted.

Firewood: Please preserve the forest ecology and do not gather wood from the park. Firewood may be purchased at the ranger station.

Generators: 50 amp. electricity is provided for RV sites 1-20. Generators are allowed between the hours of 8 a.m. and 10 p.m., so long as the noise does not disturb the peace and quiet of the campground or neighboring sites.

Pets: Pets are permitted if they are properly restrained and under the control of the owner. Dogs must be licensed and restrained on a leash no longer than 6 feet. Pets are not permitted in cabins or in vehicles parked by cabins.

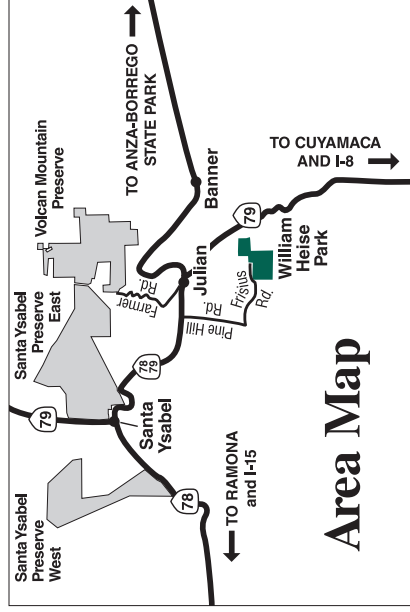
Save the Trees: Gently treated trees may live 300 years. Please do not tie or hang ropes, wires, dog leashes, hammocks, clotheslines, lights, or tents to trees. Do not drive nails, screws, staples, or tacks into trees.

Smoking: Smoking, including the use of e-cigarettes and vaporizing products, is not permitted in County parks.

Vegetation and Natural Features: All plants, animals, natural features, and archaeological resources are fully protected and may not be damaged, injured or removed.

Wastewater: Dispose of all RV wastewater in the dump station; never on the ground. Use the park provided camp-sinks for cleaning camp dishes.

Youth: All persons under 18 years of age must be accompanied by a legally responsible adult with medical authorization for each child while camping in the park. Persons under 18 must wear helmets when riding, bikes, skateboards and scooters.
