COOL CRAFTS - RUBBER BAND GUITAR

Materials:

- 1 cereal or shoe box
- 1 recycled paper towel tube
- Scissors.
- Craft knife (optional)
- 8 rubber bands
- 2 crayons



Directions:


- Using the craft knife or scissors, cut a 3 to 4-inch circle in the center of one side of the box. You
 can use a container top to trace a perfect circle or just cut it out by eye. This hole will act as your
 sound hole.
- 2. Punch two sets of six holes in a straight line at each end of the box using the craft knife, scissors or small screwdriver but do not make them too big. These holes should be close to the box edges and approximately 1/2 inch apart from each other to allow room for string vibration.
- 3. Now, using the craft knife, cut six V-shaped grooves into each crayon as shown below. The rubber band will sit in these grooves when attached.
- 4. Cut six rubber bands. Thread them through the small holes on one side of the box and tie knots from inside the box to keep them from pulling out. Then stretch each rubber band across to the matching hole on the other side and again, thread it through using a screwdriver. Secure each rubber band with another inside knot.
- 5. Then, secure the crayons in place with the two remaining rubber bands to lift the "strings" up from the box.
- 6. That's it! You can customize the look of your guitar by coloring, painting or gluing pictures on it, but the best part of this craft is being able to hear some original music!

RAD RECIPES

Beet Lemonade from our friends at Olivewood Gardens

Ingredients:

- ½ beet, juiced
- 8 meyer lemons, juiced
- 4 sprigs of mint, muddled
- 12 ounces soda water
- 3 ounces agave
- 4 nasturtium flowers
- 12 ice cubes

Directions:

- 1. Juice beet with a juicer and set aside.
- 2. Juice 8 meyer lemons using a citrus reamer and set aside.
- 3. In the bottom of a punch bowl, add mint and muddle with a wooden spoon handle until oils from mint are released.
- 4. Add agave to punch bowl with the mint. Then, add the room temperature lemon juice. Slowly add the beet juice little by little controlling the color (you are looking for a light magenta color).
- 5. Mix very well and then add in ice cubes to cool down to the desired drinking temperature.
- 6. Finally add your soda water to give it some fun fizz.
- 7. Garnish with a nasturtium flower and serve to your friends and family. Enjoy!
