- Dave Knopp, Chief of Operations gave an overview on County Trails and E-Bikes. Highlights included trail use regulations, and an overview on 2015 California Assembly Bill 1096 Vehicles: Electric Bikes and Assembly Bill 1909 The inclusion of Class 3 E-Bikes, Senate Bill 375 and benefits and concerns on e-bikes. E-bike information session flyer was shared to the committee members, and they were notified of a E-Bikes public meeting taking place at Los Penasquitos on January 28th.
- Feedback was provided by the committee members on usage of e-bikes at Penasquitos, programs that offer incentives to earn a bike, borrowing bikes from facilities, trail etiquette, concerns on e-bikes allowed at campgrounds areas.
